



Go West to Oklahoma My Riding Friends!

Reset your odometers!
The route is 123 miles. Miles given are approximate as odometers vary.
Estimated time: 3 hours

1. From NWACC, turn right (west) onto Highway 102. **[Mile 0]** Travel to J Street.
2. Turn left (south) on J Street. **[Mile 1.5]** Travel to 28th Street.
3. Turn right (west) on 28th Street (by World Gym). **[Mile 2.5]** Travel to Walton Boulevard.
4. Turn left (south) on Walton Boulevard. **[Mile 3.2]** Travel Walton a short distance and veer to the right to Highway 12.
5. Turn right (west) at Highway 12. **[Mile 3.8]** Travel Highway 12 to Gentry for 20 miles.
6. Turn left into the Phillips 66 station for **Poker Stop 1/Wild Card** at the intersection of Highway 12 and Highway 59. **[Mile 24.2]**
7. Continue west on Highway 12. In Oklahoma, Highway 12 becomes Highway 116 once you pass Highway 43 **[Mile 29.3]**.
8. Continue west on Highway 116 toward Colcord, Oklahoma. Pay attention west of Colcord for a short descending set of twisties. **[Mile 37.8]**
9. Continue to travel Highway 116 until it dead ends into Highway 10.
10. Turn left (south) onto Highway 10. **[Mile 41.9]** Travel to the intersection of Highway 10 and Scenic Highway 412.
11. Turn right into the Phillips 66 station for **Poker Stop 2** at the intersection of Highway 10 and Scenic Highway 412 just past the turnpike entrance. **[Mile 46.1]**

Note: If you are pressed for time, you can delete Steps 12 and 13 but you'll miss one of the best roads on the route. Skipping those steps will shave off 26.4 miles.

12. Continue to travel south on Highway 10 for 13 miles to the Hanging Rock Café (on your right). It will seem like you went too far.

13. Make a U-Turn at the Hanging Rock Café. **[Mile 59.3]** Travel back on Highway 10 to Scenic Highway 412 intersection.

14. Turn right (east) on Scenic Highway 412. Travel the highway into Siloam Springs.

15. Turn right into the Phillips 66 station for **Poker Stop 3** at the intersection of Highway 412 and Highway 59. **[Mile 85.1]**

16. Continue east on Highway 412 and travel through Siloam Springs.

17. Get into the left lane as you leave Siloam Springs in preparation for a hidden left turn.

18. As you pass Fairmont Road (big green highway sign on the right) **[Mile 92.2]**, you are less than 1/4 mile from your next turn (left) onto Old Highway 168.

Note: You'll see a street sign on your right for Old Highway 168. Don't turn there. The intersection where you turn left is directly across the highway from a street named Taylor Corn Road.

19. Turn left (north) on Old Highway 68. **[Mile 92.6]** Travel 9 miles to Liberty Avenue.

20. Turn left (north) on Liberty Avenue. **[Mile 101.6]** You will see a sign that says Brush Creek Baptist Church. Once on Liberty, you will see KSBN-TV 57.

Note: If you miss this turn, Old Hwy 68 will run back into Highway 412. Turn around and come back to Liberty Avenue.

21. Veer right at the fork in front of KSBN. Follow Liberty Avenue into Elm Springs.

Caution: Watch for gravel in front of Brush Creek subdivision [Mile 102.0] and the dip in the bridge in the 25 mph zone.

22. Turn left (north) In Elm Springs at the stop sign onto Highway 112. **[Mile 106.7]** Travel Highway 112 into Cave Springs.

23. Turn into the Phillips 66 Gas Station for **Poker Stop 4.** **[Mile 111.0]**

24. Continue to travel north 5.4 miles on Highway 112 into Bentonville to the Highway 12 intersection.

25. Turn right (east) onto Highway 12. **[Mile 116.4]** Travel to Walton Boulevard.

26. Turn left onto Walton Boulevard. **[Mile 116.9]** Travel to SW A Street (street not marked).

27. Veer right on SW A Street just past National Home Center and Serfco. **[Mile 118.2]** Travel a short distance to Highway 102.

28. Turn right (east) on Highway 102. **[Mile 118.4]** Travel 3 miles to Pig Trail Harley Davidson.

29. Turn into Pig Trail Harley Davidson for **Poker Stop 5.** **[Mile 121.3].**

30. Turn back right (west) onto Highway 102 to return to NWACC to turn in your poker run form for the tallying of your hand.
